a) *What is the Millennium@EDU Program?*

b) *How is the Millennium@EDU Program implemented?*

The **Millennium@EDU Program** is implemented through the **Millennium@EDU Promoters** that will develop comprehensive **Millennium@EDU Projects**, including deployment of **Millennium@EDU Packs** at the schools, giving access to computer devices to students and teachers, engaging local stakeholders as Content producers, IT industry and communication, amongst others.

c) *The Millennium@EDU Program is managed by whom?*

The **Millennium@EDU** is a multi-stakeholder initiative led by the private sector including some of the largest multinationals involved in education and technology. For that purpose a **Foundation** is created to manage the **Millennium@EDU Program** (for further information, please contact: info@millenniumedu.org).

d) *What is the Millennium@EDU Solution Pack?*

The **Millennium@EDU Solution Pack** is a comprehensive and integrated learning and education solution designed to enable access to information, communication and scientific technologies (ICSTs). The solution includes Individual Units, Shared Units and Services.

The **Millennium@EDU Solution Pack** includes the following:

Portable Computer Device, Software Suite, Labware, Teacher and Education Agent Device, Interactive Whiteboard, Portable Projector, School Server, Container Charger, Learning Management System, Educational Content, Training Programs, Deployment, Project Implementation Support and Warranty.

e) *What is the price of the **Millennium@EDU Solution Pack**?*

The price is below \$200 (two hundred US dollars) per **Millennium@EDU Solution Pack**, which represents around 20 cents of a dollar, per day, per student in three years (local taxes and local deployment not included).

f) *How many Packs are available?*

There are 15 million available Packs representing 1% (one per cent) of the young people in school age. There are extra 15 million Packs, with a different price (“although very competitive”) to extend the **Millennium@EDU Projects**.

g) *What is a **Millennium@EDU comprehensive Project**?*

A comprehensive Project is the one that covers a multitude of elements integrated in such a way to achieve specific defined results covering the improving quality and access to Education, leverage IT and Education industry and boosting access to Information and Knowledge.

h) *Who can promote a **Millennium@EDU Project**?*

The promoters of a potential **Millennium@EDU Project** should be official entities.

A non-governmental organization or a company may also be a promoter if the specific and relevant Project receives the support of an official entity.

i) *Who is entitled to fulfill or provide a **Millennium@EDU Solution Pack**?*

The **Millennium@EDU Solution Pack Provider** is the entity that is responsible to aggregate all the **Components** of the Pack.

j) *Who is entitled to deploy a **Millennium@EDU Solution Pack**?*

The **Prime Contractor** is the entity legally responsible for providing a complete **Millennium@EDU Solution Pack** to the **Millennium@EDU Promoter** or **Buyer**.

k) *What is the role of the **Millennium@EDU Foundation**?*

The **Millennium@EDU Foundation** will be responsible for managing the **Millennium@EDU Program** and, in this capacity to support the **Millennium@EDU Promoter(s)**.
